## National Playday 2008



Playday is the annual celebration of children's right to play, a national campaign supported by Play England and the Government to promote play for children and young people. This year's event took place on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2008 at the Blaydon Comprehensive old school site and was organised by the Early Years and Childcare Service.

This year's Playday theme was 'Give Us A Go'. The campaign promoted the benefits of allowing children to manage their own risks whilst playing by providing adventurous play opportunities and aimed to counter the risk-averse cotton wool culture that can limit children's play.
